IWCB Volunteer Recognition

The IWCB are running for the second year an Island recognition scheme for club volunteers. It is a chance for the Islands clubs to nominate those individuals/groups that do outstanding, uncelebrated work at their clubs.

There will be 9 categories, all nominees will receive a certificate and 9 category winners will be selected by a panel and invited to attend lunch at the Island V's MCC game on the 21st July at Ryde Cricket Club where they will also be a small presentation to the winners.

Seven of the categories winners will be put forward as the Islands nominations for the ECB's [Outstanding Service to Cricket Awards](#) (NatWest OSCA's).

The Categories are: -

***Young Volunteer-** For volunteers aged 16-25 years old

***Outside the Scorebox** - This is an award for an official who has thought 'outside the box', gone out of their comfort zone and the natural cricket audience to recruit. The award is looking for an official who has visibly increased the quantity of officials in their County and therefore help the sustainability of cricket in England and Wales.

***Behind The Scenes** - Someone invisible who your club couldn't do without!

***Building Partnerships** - Created sustainable partnerships with schools, voluntary organisations, other sports and/or the local community.

***NatWest CricketForce** - Volunteer or group of volunteers who have made an outstanding contribution to the 2009 event.

***Leagues and Boards** - Dedication with results is what we are looking for here! This can be an individual or group

***Lifetime Achiever** - We are looking for an individual who has made an outstanding difference to cricket for a sustained period.

Club Coach - A Coach that has given up their time to develop junior cricket in their club. Must be qualified.

Club Official - An Umpire or Scorers who has dedicated there time to officiating for their club.

Boost for Girls Cricket

Girls Cricket on the Island is receiving a great push at the moment with many different initiatives taking place.

The Isle of Wight Cricket Board and Ventnor CC have both been successfully in attaining funding from Awards for All to deliver coaching specifically aimed at girls. Both projects will deliver coaching in school time. Ventnor will also be offering coaching for girls at the club.

The Cricket Board will also offer subsidies to prospective female coaches to take coaching course this winter.

Northwood CC have gained £500 from the Isle of Wight Councils Sport4kids scheme (9-16Yrs) to deliver coaching at the club.

The Isle of Wight Cricket Board has also just completed a successfully Return to Sport programme for ladies cricket, aimed at 16+ the course ran over 11 weeks, with 17 ladies attending regularly. They will also be playing a number of fixtures organised across the summer.
