New Fast Bowling Directives

The ECB Fast Bowling Directives have changed following a two-year consultation process. The outcome is that bowlers up to under-15 level are now able to bowl longer spells and more overs in a day.

Under the new guidelines bowlers at under-16 and under-17 level are now permitted to bowl an extra over per spell but those in the under-18 and under-19 category have had the total number of overs they can deliver per day reduced from 21 to 18.

These guidelines will come into effect for the start of the 2010 season.

The fast bowling guidelines are designed to raise awareness of the need to nurture and protect young fast bowlers through their formative years. Research has shown that fast bowlers are by far the most likely cricketers to be missing playing and training time due to injury.

2010 League Structure Agreed

2010 will see a few changes to the Harwood's League structure.

The following changes were agreed at the Club Committee meeting on the 12th October at Newport CC.

Harwood's Div 1

Continues to comprise of 8 teams playing home and away in the league, but for next season a league cup competition will be introduced. The cup will be played in two groups of four, with each club playing three games in a forty over format with the two mini league winners playing off in the final.

Harwood's Div 2

There is a small change from the two-league structure played last year. 2010 will see the ten teams firstly play each other once and then split after that into two mini leagues, top five in Div 2 Higher and bottom five into Div 2 Lower. Each team will see the points gained in the first nine games taken forward to the split league programme. The Fred Winter Cup will be played on Saturdays (Except the Final) and will involve all Div 2 teams only.

Island Webservices Senior Cup

Will be open to all clubs for their 1st XI to enter and will be played on Sundays. This means 1st XI sides in Division 2 can enter the Island Webservices Senior Cup without compromising their entry into the Fred Winter Cup if they win through to the second round.

Midweek League & Cup

For 2010 it was agreed to not organise a midweek league and cup competition as over the last few years the number of clubs entering had dropped to a point where it was felt there was little point in organising the competitions. Another consideration that led to this outcome was the introduction of the corporate 20twenty and the Newclose Cup, which offered clubs and players a chance to get midweek cricket.

The changes to the leagues will hopefully deliver more games to teams and offer appropriate competitions to all the teams involved.

2010 unfortunately sees Cricket Brading dropping out of the league, which means that Ventnor 3rd XI taking their place in Division 1
