Prior to Christmas, Newclose County Cricket Ground was given the green light by the Isle of Wight Council to go ahead with developing both the basement and loft areas at Newclose, to create a gym and conference facility.

As part of the new planning consent, Newclose can now open twelve months of the year. During the winter season this means that from Monday to Thursday the facility is open for meetings and conferences, while the restaurant is open Friday, Saturday and Sunday lunchtimes as well as Friday and Saturday evenings.
