## Board News

### Subject: Jim Thorn.

I have been asked by the Board to write to you to formally announce that Jim Thorn has regretfully resigned from the Board, and as a Director of Isle of Wight Cricket Board Limited, with immediate effect.

During his time on the Board and particularly in his role as Chairman, Jim has worked tirelessly in the interest of Island cricket, often in the face of many difficult challenges.

The role of a Board member, in respect of commitment of time and energy is increasingly demanding, and Jim has now found that following his business now taking off, he feels he is unable to commit the necessary time needed to perform as Chairman or indeed as a member of the Board.

The Board have, with regret, accepted Jim's resignation and following the Board meeting of 4<sup>th</sup> January 2011, it was unanimously agreed to accept an offer from Ron Cook to step in as Acting Chairman pending a formal vote at the February Board meeting. Ron has stated his willingness to assume the Chair formally on the proviso that the membership is in support of him doing so. If anyone has any objection to Ron becoming Chairman then please inform me in writing as it will mean that a Special General Meeting will need to be called and a formal nomination process and subsequent vote followed.

Charlie Millington has been voted as a Director of Isle of Wight Cricket Board Limited.

Jim's resignation means that there is now a vacancy on the Board as an ordinary member, not an Officer, and I would therefore ask anyone who is interested in playing an active and positive role in helping to drive Island cricket forwards to inform me in writing or by e-mail before 29<sup>th</sup> January 2011. The Board will then vote on the applications or in the event of no one expressing an interest then the Board will seek to co-opt a suitable person.
