The EPP players will be working for regional selection at the end of their U14 season for the following year at U15 and the Bunbury Festival. The U13 and 16 players will be working towards the National Cricket Talent Test. All of these programmes lead into the England Development Programme (EDP).

The two groups work on a Monday evening from 19:00 – 21:00 and have individual coaching throughout the week. The County Performance Manager Elliot Wilson oversees the programme. Elliot is now one of a small group of Level 4 coaches worldwide. The cost of this programme is fully subsidised by the Isle of Wight Cricket Board.

In addition the group will meet in the coming weeks with the ECB Regional Performance Manager, Steve Williams. At this meeting a twelve-month development plan will be discussed to incorporate all the players cricketing, school and life demands.

The group will also be working with the equivalent programme at Hampshire CCC where it is led by the Islands Charlie Freeston.

This group now has the opportunity to follow in the footsteps of other Islanders such as Danny Briggs, David Griffiths, Steve Snell, Chris Russell and Tom Friend.
