Adam Hose is looking forward to well and truly "immersing himself" in the Warwickshire set-up when he returns to England next month after wintering in Australia.

The Bears batsman has spent the last three months down under in Adelaide where he has been playing grade cricket for Kensington District.

The 25-year-old reports that his stay has been "good prep" for the new county season in England - and has left him champing at the bit to get cracking back with the Bears ahead of his first full season at Edgbaston.

Hose, who made a spectacular entry for the Bears with some explosive innings in the NatWestT20Blast last season, is aiming to excel in all formats in 2018 having been kept out of championship cricket last year due to a condition of his midsummer switch from Somerset.

"It's been good prep in Adelaide," he said. "I have played some red and white-ball cricket, played matches at weekends and trained three times a week.

"I've also been doing a lot of gym work because I know the guys back at Edgbaston have been getting beasted! Every time I talk to them they have just had some fitness tests, so I have made sure I have kept up over here.
