ECB SMALL GRANTS SCHEME



In 2019, the ECB Small Grant Scheme will support the ECB national programme 'Get the Game On'. All projects will assist Clubs to improve their long-term sustainability by increasing the number of games played during the season.

Club Eligibility, The scheme is open to all Affiliated Cricket Clubs, subject to County Cricket Board (CCB) support. All Clubs will need to have the following:

- Partnership Funding (minimum of 10% contribution from the club)
- A Constitution
- Valid Buildings, Contents & Public Liability Insurance
- Security of Tenure – Leasehold, Freehold or Rental Agreement (minimum one year)

Any Club which received an award from the ECB Small Grant Scheme 2018 for covers under the project theme 'Get the Game On' is not eligible to reapply in 2019.

Eligibility Projects

Clubs can apply for funding towards the purchase of the following products:

- New mobile covers
- Flat sheet covers
- Bowlers run-up and / or side sheet covers
- Replacement cover tops
- Water removal equipment (only when combined with the purchase of covers)

Awards will be between £1,000 and £4,000 per application. The award may not be used to retrospectively fund projects.
