## Honours go to Newport

Newport followed up their success of last season's indoor league with a cup victory after a convincing 96-run win over Ryde in the final.

Newport batted first and started well through openers, Gareth Bricknell and Tom Dye. The latter was first to fall, as he was run out for 18 but the run rate was incredibly high and Newport were in a strong position. Harry Dye was also run out, making 20, and Bricknell returned to the dugout after retiring on 25.

Harris Payne made just 6 before he was stumped by Rob Hobbs off the bowling of Mark Oatley, and Nat Riddett became the second batsman to retire. Bricknell returned to the crease and added 17 more before he was caught for a well made 42.

Riddett was the final wicket to fall, making 30 and Louis Payne added an important 23 not out. Newport finished on a massive 159-5, Stuart Robertson the pick of the Ryde bowlers, finishing with 1-29 from his three overs.

In reply, Ryde got off to a dreadful start and lost wickets at regular intervals. Mark Oatley (6) and Julion Jayerajah (0) were run out in successive deliveries, before Stuart Robertson fell in the same manner for 2. Lawrence Tolfrey fell to Harris Payne for 8 before Rob Hobbs went to Harry Dye without scoring, leaving Ryde 49-5.

However, young Jordan Galsworthy batted well and was the star performer for Ryde, he made 29 before he was well caught by Bricknell off Riddett, Ryde ended on 63 all out.

- Level 1 – 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> March & 4<sup>th</sup> April, Venue TBC. 3 hours each evening (6-9pm). The cost of the course will be £50pp, includes membership 1<sup>st</sup> year Membership of ACO
