## Six for Victory

The 17<sup>th</sup> September saw the rearranged Fred Winter Memorial Cup final take place at Westhill and it turned out to be a classic.

Freshwater won the toss and decided to put their opponents Godshill-Shanklin in for a bat on what looked a damp wicket but the opening pair of Dave Wood (46) and Seb Edgerton-Read (23) put on 45 until Edgerton-Read was caught of the bowling of Grant Richardson (1-26). Harry Moore stay at the crease was short lived as he was removed by Jack Lees (36-1). Chris Davis made 12 but it was Trevor Mew that really moved the score forward as he hit 41 until Mike Holiday accounted for Mews wicket. Richard Lloyd (18) and Cory Sanderson (11) were the only other batters to make double figures. Godshill-Shanklin finally setting their visitors 169.

Freshwater's reply started slowly as both openers Holiday 13 & Holbrook 3 struggled and were removed cheaply. Graham Gosden and Grant Richardson put the run chase back on track with a 90 runs partnership and put Freshwater back in the driving seat until Seb Edgerton-Read (4-24) removed Gosden for 30. , Dunn-Coleman, Van der Castlelee and Lees only added 8 runs between them, leaving Godshill-Shanklin as the favourites to the lift the cup. Richard Routledge came to the creases along-side Renwick and edged the score slowly towards the required 169 but still had plenty to do as the game entered the last over (10 of 6), even with 1 ball left 5 was required to win the game. Routledge secured the cup and his Freshwater CC hero status as he blasted the final ball for 6, giving them a 1 wicket victory and washing away the disappointment of last year's loss.
